



As we start the month of February, we have already been being reminded of the major holiday, Valentine's Day, since right before Christmas.

Valentine's Day celebrates love, and what that means for you and your spouse or partner. I thought I would remind everyone this month of a great resource that can help us find the love that we all crave.

P&STOR'S CORNER

In 1992 a groundbreaking book was published by Dr. Gary Chapman called "The Five Love Languages - How to Express Heartfelt Commitment to Your Mate." Since then, that book has expanded from a book just for married couples, into books for teens and children as well.

So this month I want to share those 5 languages with you. I pray that they will help you find the love and joy that we all need in our lives.

Love Language #1: Words of Affirmation

These are words that build you up. Giving compliments and words of appreciation.

Love Language #2: Quality Time

By "quality time", that means that you are giving someone your **undivided** attention. This means actually looking at the person and talking to them, not at them.

Love Language #3: Receiving Gifts

Gifts come in all sizes, colors, and shapes. Some are expensive, some are free. They can be purchased, found, or made. One of the most powerful gifts is the **gift of self** to someone else.

Love Language #4: Acts of Service

This means doing things that you know that your spouse, child, or friend would like you to do.

Love Language #5: Physical Touch

Physical touch can make or break a relationship. A hand shake, hug, embrace of some type is what can fill many people's love tank.

I could go further and explain each language, but I encourage you to buy the book if you don't have a copy. If you already have a copy, take it off the shelf and reread it. What a great way to bring joy back into your life with knowing what fills not only your own love tank, but the love tanks of others.

RECYCLING

Below is a list of what they can recycle:

- Plastic Water Bottles/Plastic Soda Bottles/Gallon Water Jugs (remove lid, crush bottle, replace lid)
- Soda Cans / Beer Cans (Crush)
- Glass Beer Bottles / Glass Soda Bottles

It **must** say **CRV-California** on the item.

- No plastic milk bottles or SOUP CANS!
- No wine bottles.
- PLEASE!!!! Separate bags for plastic, glass, and aluminum cans.

Drop your recycling off any time! The bin is located next to the garbage cans in front of the patio.
