PASTOR'S CORNER

November is a transitional month. Depending on where we live, it helps us transition from Fall to Winter. It is also transitional in that we begin to prepare for our major holidays (Thanksgiving and Christmas). It is also a transitional month in the life of our church.

November is Stewardship month. Our stewardship theme for this year is **Build Your Kingdom Here**. What does it mean for us to be the hands and feet of Jesus in Discovery Bay and the surrounding communities? How will we fund our ministry outreach into our community? That is a crucial question of any stewardship campaign. We will look at the last two sections of Mark 12 for these answers. What will the ministry look like a year from now with our new buildings? On **Sunday, November 17th**, we will be consecrating our pledge cards.

We close November by preparing for Advent. Thanksgiving falls after Christ the King Sunday this year, which seems appropriate. Because Christ is King, we have received the gift of eternal life. That gift is reason enough to be thankful, and we should take time on Thanksgiving to be specific with God about all that we are thankful for. I close with these words from the Apostle Paul to the church at Philippi.

Philippians 4:4-7 (NIV)

- "4.) Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
- 5.) Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.
- 6.) Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
- 7.) And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
